Agenda No. 1 Approval of Minutes of last GB meeting

Minutes of last GB meeting held during the National Conference at Science City, Kolkata were put up on the website of IAPSM and also published in the IJCM.

Agenda No. 2 Activity report by Head Quarter IAPSM

President briefed all activities carried out by IAPSM during 2017-18. Following activities were carried out by the IAPSM during the year.

1. Organizing World Health Day quiz in around 315 Medical Colleges and IAPSM-WHD Video Competition, in which 116 videos were prepared by UG/PG students and uploaded on youtube.
2. Collaboration with Consortium Against Rabies and organizing e-Poster Competition on the occasion of Rabies Day.
3. Formation of the MIYCN committee and launching of Mission 1000 days in collaboration with Alive and Thrive in the current conference.
4. Development of the toolkit for Life Skill Education and Health Promotion targeting school children with the aim to promoting health in the children and adolescent and release of the same in the current conference.
5. Developing UG syllabus with learning objectives for each chapter to make it relevant to the current time and country's needs and planned to prepare a multiauthor book under the aegis of IAPSM and get released in next conference.
6. Prepared the draft Technical and Operational Guidelines for UHTC and RHTC.
7. Have a discussion on key declaration points on CM subject in the National Conference and to be released in the IJCM as official recommendations of IJCM.
8. Preparing a compendium on Best Practices and innovations in the teaching/training and Community Medicine Practices. Decided to have special session in the National Conference and awarding best of them.

Agenda No. 4 Report by Chief Editor IJCM : Financial situation and Progress

Dr. Pradeep Kumar, Chief Editor, IJCM presented the technical and financial report of IJCM in detail and appraised about the improvement in the financial condition of the IJCM through various cost cutting measures, getting advertisement and sponsorships. Also, he informed that in newer agreement with the Medknow, revenue sharing terms were revised more in favor of IJCM, which was otherwise more beneficial to the Medknow. GBM has appreciated efforts of IJCM team for streamlining the functioning of the IJCM and improving the financial status.

Agenda No. 5 Amendments in the constitution.

Five amendments were placed based on the GC meeting discussion and recommendations by Governing council. After diligent discussions following amendment passed with more than two third majority.

1. Wherever the word teacher or Professor is placed as eligibility for contesting various posts in IAPSM or for getting awards or orations etc. will be replaced with a life (permanent) member of IAPSM.
2. To ensure due representation from the state/zones, a committee is constituted to look in to the member strength of each state/zone and make recommendations
 1. Dr. Harivansh Chopra- Chairman
 2. Dr. Zile Singh - Member
 3. Dr. Bhavesh Modi- Member

The Committee has to submit its report within 3 months. It was also recommended to work out the TOR for the Executive Members.

3. Financial powers of sanctioning expenditure by President and of the Secretary General revised to Rs. 50000/- and Rs. 25000/- respectively. Beyond this, expenditure can be made only after the approval of Governing Council members. This approval if deemed necessary can be obtained by circulating agenda through email. However, for the grant (s) received from any external agency in between, expenditure will be done as per their respective guidelines and sanctioned budget.
4. It was resolved that minimum 50 life members shall be there for formation of any state chapter. Once a state chapter is formed than it cannot be formal part of the zonal chapter. However, such state chapters can associate with nearby state chapter/zonal chapter for organizing academic activities like conference, CME etc. Small states and UTs where the member strength is less than 50, may align with neighboring chapters.
5. A category of associate member is included. Essential eligibility of such associate member shall be minimum educational qualification of MBBS with postgraduate diploma/ master or the PhD in Public health/ Community Medicine/ PSM mainly DPH, DCM, DNB/MPH/MHA. Any new appropriate PG Degree or diploma for the consideration may be inducted only after due approval of GBM. Associate member shall have all the rights of a permanent member except the voting right as well as holding the post. For permanent membership eligibility criteria is MD (PSM/CM/SPM). PG students in MD (PSM/CM/SPM) and degrees approved for associate members can be register but they will be registered as provisional members and appropriate category of membership will be assigned on submission of proof of completion of Post graduate degrees/diploma.

Teacher in PSM department in a medical college as an eligibility criterion is removed with prospective effect.

Agenda No. 6: Financial report by the treasurer and approval of next budget.

Dr. Manish Rana, treasurer IAPSM presented the audited financial report and proposed budget. It was approved by GBM and passed.

- a. Return on fixed deposits is progressively decreasing and are also liable to be taxed. in view of this, GB approved and authorized Secretary General to invest maximum up to 33.3% (1/3rd) of untied corpus (at present being put in the fixed deposits in Bank), for up to 365 days in approved mutual fund (s) with due professional advice.
- b. It was reiterated again that all state chapters shall have their own PAN card and nobody shall use IAPSM PAN card **without advance written permission from head office**. In case of any such incidence, all legal liabilities will be with the concerned persona/state chapter. Secretary General also informed that henceforth any such unauthorized use of IAPSM PAN Card will be intimated to the income tax department.

Agenda No. 7: Approval of new state chapters

Proposals to form state chapters for Himachal and Kerala were approved.

Agenda No. 8: Partnership with other agencies

It was informed that IAPSM has received invitation to collaborate from PHFI and IQVIN. It was decided it IAPSM can collaborate with these organization keeping the interest and benefit of the IAPSM in mind.

It was proposed that under organized medicine an attempt is being made to form a GUILD of various associations and national organization. Annual membership fee for the same is Rs.25000. It was approved to be associated with the GUILD keeping the interest and benefit to the association in mind

Agenda no 9: Change of name from IAPSM to IACM

The proposal was not approved.

Agenda No. 10 : Venue for the next Conference

Proposal from I G Medical College, Shimla, Himachal Pradesh to organize next conference for the year 2019 was approved by the GBM.

- b. There were two proposals from BHU, Varanasi and AIIIMs, New Delhi to hold National conference during the year 2020. It was decided that these two proposals can be put up for discussion and approval to the next Governing Council and GBM.


