

Nomination and Eligibility Criteria for Dr. Sushila Nayar Young IAPSM Orator – 2025

For Dr. Sushila Nayar Young IAPSM orator, nomination must be submitted by an applicant who is a Life Members of IAPSM and aged equal or less than 35 years.

Oration awards: - Maximum **02 (Two) Orations** will be awarded each year:

1. **Category 1:** Academic & Research (1 award)
(Applicants with major contribution in teaching institutes, Research institutes etc.)
2. **Category 2:** Non-academic (1 award)
(Applicants with major contribution in NGO, Public health system, Development agencies)

Eligibility:

1. Postgraduates and professionals in early stage of their career, and age equal or less than 35 years.
2. He/she must be a IAPSM Life member.
3. He/she must register for IAPSM Young Leaders' Conclave before **31th October 2025 (Attach proof of registration along with application)**.

Application process:

1. The nominee will have to self-nominate herself/himself by filling the nomination form and should be recommended by a minimum of two (02) IAPSM Life Members.
2. It is mandatory that the applicant attaches proof of age and one set of detailed curriculum vitae along with the nomination form. The CV of the nominee with photo-copies of the relevant supporting documents must be arranged as specified in the nomination form.
3. Nomination application window will be opened at time of announcement of IAPSM Young Leaders' Conclave and the participants will have to submit their nomination through online forms or emails.

Review process:

1. All the nominations will be reviewed by an Independent Expert Committee; which will shortlist maximum 5 candidates based on merit of their nomination (maximum 03 for Category-1 and 02 for Category-2). Nominations found not-suitable of lack merit will be rejected by Expert Committee.
2. The Independent Expert Committee of 5 members from diverse background will consists of:
 - a) Secretary-General, IAPSM or his/her nominee
 - b) Current years' IAPSM YLC Organizing President/ Secretary
3 other members nominated by National President, IAPSM:
 - c) 01 IAPSM-GC member from any other zone where the YLC is being organized
 - d) 01 IAPSM Life Member (Academic Background)
 - e) 01 IAPSM Life Member (Non-academic Background)
3. The shortlisted candidates will make an online presentation before a minimum of 3-member Jury from the above Expert Committee. 02 best presentations (01 each from academic and non-academic category) will be awarded the Oration during the IAPSM-YLC; rest of the candidates will be awarded certificate of appreciation.
4. The shortlisted awardees will be informed to attend and present their abstract with future vision in the IAPSM Young Leaders' Conclave. The candidates will be individually communicated at least 10 days in advance to facilitate preparation for delivery of their presentation. In case of inability to attend physically the next candidate in waiting will be asked to deliver the oration
5. It is expected that the abstracts are based on some original scientific work/public health contribution undertaken by the candidate or some vital topic of public health importance with their futuristic vision.
6. The decision of the Independent Expert Committee for shortlisting of candidates and Jury for Oration will be final and cannot be contested against or challenged.

7. All the above process will be facilitated by IAPSM Young Leaders' Conclave Organizing Committee.

Oration award:

1. The Orators will be awarded with a medal and a citation.
2. A person chosen for an Oration can use the suffix "*Dr. Sushila Nayar Young IAPSM Orator*" only after receiving the citation for the same.

- Submit your CV / Bio-data along with nomination form (as a separate file)
- All applications will be reviewed by Independent Expert Committee.
- Incomplete or late nominations will be automatically rejected.
- **Last date of submission: 31st October 2025**
- **Announcement of Oration Award: 15th November 2025**
