

- The symposium on the National Tuberculosis Elimination Program (NTEP) was chaired by Dr. Bhardwaj, highlighting strategies for TB control with insights from panel experts including WHO Consultant Dr. Shruthi Rajan.
- The second day featured a session on Front of Package Labeling presented by Miss Vaishalli Soni from PGIMER Chandigarh, emphasizing healthy food guidelines as per NIN standards. This session was chaired by Dr. Bhardwaj and Dr. Gupta, promoting awareness about nutrition.







42nd IAPSMCON OSB 2024 -

Annual Conference of IAPSM Odisha State Chapter



42nd IAPSMCON OSB 2024

- The 42nd State Annual Conference of the Indian Association of Preventive and Social Medicine (IAPSM), Odisha State Branch, was held on 13-14 December 2024 at IMS & SUM Hospital, Siksha 'O' Anusandhan University, Bhubaneswar. Organized by the Department of Community Medicine, the conference focused on the theme "Mainstreaming Tribal Health: Towards Universal Health Coverage."
- The event was led by Organising Chairperson Prof. (Dr.) Sumitra Pattanaik, Co-chairperson Prof. (Dr.) E. Venkata Rao, and Organising Secretary Prof. (Dr.) Lipilekha Patnaik. It saw participation from around 250 faculty members, students, and healthcare professionals from across India.
- Dr. Annarao Kulkarni (President, IAPSM) and Dr. Purushottam Giri (Secretary General, IAPSM) both attended as Guests of Honour for this conference.
- Two pre-conference workshops were conducted: one on "Health Economics" by Dr. Sarit Kumar Rout (IIPH, Bhubaneswar) and another on statistical analysis using web-based software by Dr. Sachin Siddheswar Mumbare (ARMC Hospital, Solapur).
- The conference featured six plenary sessions, including an Oration and a panel discussion, covering topics like adult immunization, artificial intelligence, and tribal health. The R.G. Panigrahi Oration was delivered by an eminent professor of community medicine in Odisha. Renowned speakers from institutions such as UNICEF and RMRC Bhubaneswar contributed their insights.
- Scientific sessions included 25 oral presentations and 31 posters from 56 submitted abstracts. Topics ranged from maternal and child health, communicable and non-communicable diseases, occupational health, nutrition, tobacco use, medical education, and sanitation, with a special focus on tribal health.
- The General Body Meeting and state body elections were held with active participation. Winners of various sessions were awarded during the valedictory ceremony, where eminent faculty were also felicitated for their contributions to community medicine in Odisha.

- Plenary Sessions were covering important topics like Tuberculosis (TB) Eradication in India; Public Health Strategies for Combating Communicable and Non-Communicable Diseases in Tamil Nadu; Malaysia's Experience in Training Public Health Medicine Specialists and Integrating Public Health into Hospitals for Increased Preparedness and Resilience; Global Measles and Rubella Elimination; Role of genomics in Infectious disease surveillance; Holistic Approach to aging population etc.
- In addition, the scientific presentations stood out across the board, with 131 abstracts. The young minds competed through oral and poster presentation sessions where students presented innovative research with clarity and passion.

- These sessions provided participants with hands-on training and practical insights, fostering skill development in various domains of public health research and management.
- The event was attended by 513 registered participants, representing various academic institutions, healthcare organizations, and public health bodies.
- The inauguration ceremony was graced by eminent dignitaries, including Prof. Sanjay Zodpey, President of the Public Health Foundation of India, as the Chief Guest, and Dr. Annarao Kulkarni, IAPSM National President, as the Guest of Honour.

IAPSM Public Health Infographics (IPHI)

- Infographics, combining information with visuals, are a powerful tool for communicating public health messages effectively. Visual content is processed 60,000 times faster than text and is more memorable, enhancing the long-term impact of critical health data. Additionally, infographics transcend language barriers, making them accessible to individuals with varying health literacy levels.
- The initiative, titled IAPSM Public Health Infographics (IPHI), was launched as part of the broader activities under the Indian Association of Preventive and Social Medicine (IAPSM). The initiative aimed to foster the creation and dissemination of high-quality public health visuals through an ongoing process of infographic submissions.

• Submission Process

• Interested individuals were invited to submit their infographics via call for submissions for various themes, adhering to detailed submission guidelines provided on the IAPSM national webpage. Each submission underwent an initial review by a dedicated team to ensure quality, relevance, and originality through plagiarism checks.

· Social Media Promotion

• Approved submissions were promoted across various social media platforms to maximize outreach and engagement. Creators were tagged in these posts, providing them with enhanced recognition and an expanded audience.

• Recognition of Excellence

• Top-performing infographics were selected by the review team, with the names of the creators showcased on social media platforms. This recognition aimed to encourage sustained participation and excellence in public health infographic creation.

• Webpage Display

All approved infographics were organized and displayed on the IAPSM national webpage.
 They were categorized by themes and grouped under various issues, ensuring easy accessibility for educational and outreach purposes.

• Theme 1: Poshan Maah

The first theme, Poshan Maah, received a total of 20 submissions. Of these, 16 infographics were selected and compiled into Graphic-e-Health Edition 1, Issue 1. The winners for this theme were Dr. Krupa Sravanthi and Dr. Poojitha Shreeradha, whose work was recognized for its exceptional quality and impact.

• Theme 2: Mental Health

- The second theme, Mental Health, attracted a total of 54 submissions. Among these, 28 infographics were chosen for inclusion in Graphic-e-Health Edition 1, Issue 2. The winners for this theme were Dr. Markapudi Prasanna Kumarand and Dr. Hemangini Kishore Shah, acknowledged for their outstanding contributions to the initiative.
- Both themes highlighted the engagement and creativity of participants, contributing significantly to the success of the IPHI initiative.
