Conferences organized by the IAPSM or under the banner of IAPSM


Completed

Week 1-3: Weekly online discussion on selected topics;





Used to register and vaccinate every pregnant woman, record her delivery outcome, register every newborn delivery, administer birth doses and all vaccination events thereafter.

Single source of information for immunisation services, updating vaccination status, delivery outcome, planning of RI sessions and reports like antigen-wise coverage, reminders for upcoming doses and follow-up of dropouts etc.



Generate real-time data of routine immunisation sessions and vaccination coverage.



HIV self-testing to take off in India: findings from the STAR Initiative³

As recommended by WHO, HIV self-testing (HIVST) is an important step to address gaps in HIV diagnoses including among key populations.

Unitaid funded Self Testing Africa (STAR) initiative is a novel initiative aiming to expand access to HIV testing and linkages to care, particularly among key populations and vulnerable communities.

In this initiative distribution of self-test kits with comprehensive information and counselling services through community-based organizations, pharmacies, and online platforms, coupled.

Can address several challenges such as stigma, lack of privacy, and limited access to healthcare facilities.



<u>Trial Run of Blood Bag Delivery under the iDrone Initiative of ICMR</u> <u>successfully conducted</u>⁴

This ground-breaking validation study marks the first of its kind in the country and is the result of collaborative efforts between ICMR, Lady Hardinge Medical College (LHMC) in New Delhi, Government Institute of Medical Sciences (GIMS) in Greater Noida, and Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT) in Noida.



During the inaugural trial flight, 10 units of whole blood samples were transported from GIMS to LHMC within the visual line of sight. Scientists from ICMR headquarters undertook the protocol development, study design, implementation, and coordination of the project.



National Health Accounts Estimates for India (2019-20) released 5

The share of Out-of-Pocket Expenditure (OOPE) in Total Health Expenditure (THE) declined from 62.6% in 2014-15 to 47.1% in 2019-20, while Government Health Expenditure's share in the GDP increased from 1.13% to 1.35% during the same period.

The share of Government Health Expenditure in Total Health Expenditure also rose from 29% to 41.4%. Per capita Government spending on healthcare doubled.

Rise in Social Security Expenditure on healthcare, leading to reduced out-of-pocket payments. The report urged state governments to increase healthcare spending as a percentage of their total budget, promoting citizens' welfare.
